In RE, Year 3 have been learning about the **Sacrament of Reconciliation**. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a celebration of God's love and mercy; it is about the forgiveness of sin and being reconciled with God and one another. Year 3 discussed how all **choices** have **consequences**.

Annabella has written a book called '**A guide to good choices**'. She has thought about; the importance of conscience, sinning and penance, and how all of these things contribute to whether we do the right thing. Annabella has included different ways we can make the right choice such as praying, asking for help and not sinning. She has given detailed explanations of what all of this means and the consequences of these actions.
