Anti-Bullying Week...

We've been working hard this week learning about what to do if you think you or a friend is being bullied. We all took part in workshops and special assemblies to help us understand what is and what isn't bullying. We talked about what to do and who to talk to. Our school definitions of bullying come from Kidscape:



Bullying is the repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power.

We also talked about what is not bullying. These things sometimes need adult help to sort out, but are not bullying:


Friends being "mean" to each other in a one off incident.

Children having an argument or disagreement with each other in which they have both participated and there is no imbalance of power.


Our key message is... Always tell an adult.

We're all working on being kind to each other:)


