General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

In order to achieve compliance and to ensure that St Eugene's is prepared for the new
legislation which becomes law on 25th May, we have taken the following steps:-

1. We have completed a GDPR Compliance Audit.
2. We have written a policy outlining new rights.
3. We have written a privacy notice (the policy and privacy notice are on websites)
4. We have appointed a DPO (data protection officer) who will be employed by the
schools from the Camden Corporate Data Protection Team
5. We completed a compliance review of the schools' contractors (e.g. Bug Club) and
have taken action to ensure their GDPR preparations are in order.

We therefore comply with the new legislation. If you have any queries regarding this please see Mrs Smith.
